
TRAVELLING TO THE SCP LONDON OFFICE



31 SOUTHAMPTON ROW, LONDON, WC1B 5HJ – 020 3376 6660

The SCP office in London is located in Holborn which is easily accessible by tube, bus, train, bike, and car. The building is located round the corner from Bloomsbury Square Gardens. The office is located three doors down from the junction of Southampton Row/ Vernon Place.

By Tube: Holborn Station is a 2 minute walk south of the office. It is served by the Central Line with services running from West Ruislip, Hainault, White City and Epping. There is also a Piccadilly Line with connections from Heathrow Airport, Oakwood and Uxbridge.

By Train: There are number of stations within close proximity to the office. To the north lies London Euston which is less than 20 minutes walk, whilst Kings Cross and St. Pancras are less than 25 minutes walk. Connections from these stations vary from local services within Greater London to all major stations across the UK and Europe.

By Cycle: Barclays Cycle Hire is available from Southampton Place which is a 3 minute walk to the south-west of the site. Bikes can be used and then deposited at other docking stations throughout London. There is cycle parking located near to the junction of Southampton Place.

By Bus: There are a number of frequent services at stops on the surrounding roads including those along Vernon Way, Southampton Way and High Holborn. The nearest bus stops are on Bloomsbury Way which re served by a wide range of buses including include routes running to/from Victoria and Oxford Circus.

By Car: There are a number of major routes running near to the site. Heading from the M1 for example you could take the A41, followed by the A501 until you came to Southampton Row. Whilst on-street parking bays are limited there is public parking available at Bloomsbury Square with 450 spaces available.
